

All Trainees must report to Field Exercise with the following Wildland Firefighter Personal Protective Equipment

There are Seven (7) basic items which every wildland firefighter trainee must possess when reporting to a hosted field exercise day.

1. **NFPA 1977 SPEC HARDHAT (not Fireman's Helmet)**
2. **NFPA 1977 SPEC GOGGLES/EYE PROTECTION**
3. **NFPA 1977 SPEC. FIRE SHIRT**
4. **NFPA 1977 SPEC. LEATHER FIRE GLOVES**
5. **NFPA 1977 SPEC. FIRE SHELTER**
6. **NFPA 1977 SPEC. FIRE PANTS, JEAN or "BDU" STYLE
(may be large enough to be used as an "overpant") or
NFPA 1977 SPEC. YELLOW "OVERPANT"**
7. **FIRELINE BOOTS**
Note: See minimum specification detail below

Any other items such as gear packs, radio packs, etc. are entirely optional and not required.



Boots: "Wildland" boots must meet at least the following requirements

1. Eight inch minimum boot height
2. All leather uppers (No synthetic collars or panels)
3. Lace up (no zippers)
4. Defined heel
5. Oil resistant Soles
6. Rating of Good or Better on sole heat resistance
7. Non-slip sole – NO steel toe
